The National Arts and Humanities Month of October 2022.

October is the National Arts and Humanities Month as declared by the President of the United States and echoed by our own Governor Honorable Lemanu Palemoi Sialega Peleti Mauga.

In celebration of this special month, we are inviting students from the Public and Private Schools to help commemorate the The National Arts and Humanities by participating in an <u>Essay and Poetry Writing</u> <u>Competition</u>.

Theme of the competition:

"Save our Samoan Language and Culture from Extinction." "Faasao le Gagana Samoa ma le Aganu'u ina nei mou atu."

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be enrolled in a public or private school.
- Must be in Grade 5 12.

The competition is in two tiers with 4 categories each.

1. Tier I: High School Levels 9-12

Category 1: Samoan Essay Writing (750-1,000 words) Category 2: English Essay Writing (750-1,000 words)

Category 3: Samoan Poetry Writing (300-500 words)

Category 4: English Poetry Writing (300-500 words)

2. Tier II: Elementary Levels 5-8

Category 1: Samoan Essay Writing (750-1,000 words)

Category 2: English Essay Writing (750-1,000 words)

Category 3: Samoan Poetry Writing (300-500 words)

Category 4: English Poetry Writing (300-500 words)

For all Poetry entries; MUST have no less than 6 stanzas and 6 lines each stanza.

- Cover Page
- must have Name, Age, School, Grade and Title
- Font Times New Roman, Font size 12, Double Space
- Originality of ideas
- Plagiarizing is an automatic disqualification
- Structure
- Must be in the order of, Introduction, Body and Conclusion.
- Expression
- Relevance
- Grammar and Spelling
- Creativity

Judging Criteria for Poetry:

- Cover Page
- must have Name, Age, School, Grade and Title
- Originality of ideas
- Plagiarizing is an automatic disqualification.
- Coherence of form and Structure
- Fluency and Expression
- Relevance to the theme
- Grammar and Spelling
- Creativity
